**Effective January 1, 2005 POMS is Mandatory**

The POMS On-Line CG-5132 form will replace the CG-5132 and CG-5132-1 PDF forms accessed via the National Forms Web site. Per COMDTINST M16790.1F page 9.3: Patrol orders, reimbursable or non-reimbursable, are issued using the Patrol Order Management System (POMS) to order the use of an Auxiliary facility (*vessel, airplane, and communication station*). Use of POMS is mandatory.

All Operations (Air, Surface and Mobile Radio) Certified Auxiliary Members have Internet access to the POMS On-Line CG-5132 form and the Operations Schedule for your POMS location. You will need the latest CITRIX Client and POMS.ICA to access POMS. The POMS Installation and the POMS On-Line CG-5132/7030 User's guides are available at: <<http://www.statronics.com/poms/>> Click on POMS Documentation. Assistance with the installation and use of POMS is available via your local POMS Administration Team. They can be identified via your Operations chain of administration.

The FINCEN will discontinue processing paper CG-5132 Forms as announced by the CG Finance Center at the 2004 NACON. Note: As of 01 January 2005, the CG-5132 and CG-5132-1 PDF files will be removed from the National forms web site.

**MANDATORY WORKSHOPS - 2005 -002/05**

- The following Auxiliary program workshops have direct AUXDATA entry deadlines for 2005 and must be attended to maintain certification:
  - Operations (OP) workshop
  - Vessel Examiner (VE)/RBS Program Visitor (RBS-VP) workshop
  - Instructor (IT) workshop
- If attendance at these workshops is not entered in AUXDATA by May 31, then AUXDATA will place the certified person in REWK status. If the workshop has not been attended and entered in AUXDATA by September 30, then that person will be placed in REYR status.
- Participants in operations, vessel examination/RBS-program visitor, and instructor programs attend these workshops well in advance and follow with appropriate AUXDATA entries.

Take advantage of the workshops that Member Training is providing – don't jeopardize your certification. See *Training Corner*, back of newsletter, for up coming dates.

 Subj: OPERATIONAL DRESS UNIFORM (ODU) AVAILABILITY - 001/05

1 - The Coast Guard-wide ODU roll-out is now complete in that ODU orders by Coast Guard Auxiliarists can be accepted and processed by the Coast Guard Uniform Distribution Center (UDC) in Woodbine, NJ. Due to initial supply constraints, orders should be limited to a maximum of two sets of ODUs per Auxiliarist. It is expected that Auxiliarists will be able to place unlimited orders by April 2005.

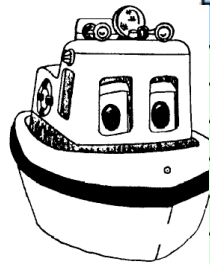
2 - The UDC phone number for placing uniform orders is 1-800-874-6841. The UDC web site is <http://www.uscg.mil/hq/g-w/g-wp/udc/index.htm> Immediately upon accessing the UDC web site, Auxiliarists will see a special notice pertaining to their ODU orders. This notice has a link that will take them to the Standard Order form that should be used to generate an ODU order.

3 - Auxiliarists are strongly encouraged to use the ODU sizing guide (available on the UDC web site under "ODU Uniform") because the ODU outfit is quite different from the working blue uniform. Additionally, working blue uniform items are still available through UDC at significantly reduced costs and they are authorized for Auxiliary wear until no longer serviceable.
